### **INTRO**

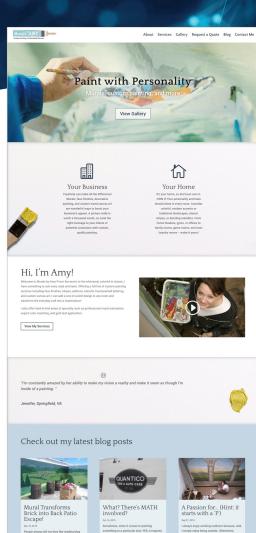

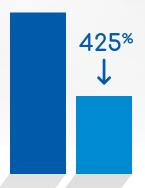
We wanted to demonstrate more tangibly how our services help our clients to grow their businesses. To do this, we focused on Amy Tubbs, a local mural artist with a very successful small business. When Amy first contacted Pier5, she was frustrated with her website setup as she was not gaining the level of new clientele she had been at first. She explained her needs to us and we were able to build her a new, intuitive, functional website with updated branding content. We also moved her previous blog posts to her new site and now maintain it so she can focus on more important things, like making spaces come to life with her art! #### **INCOME VS COST**
